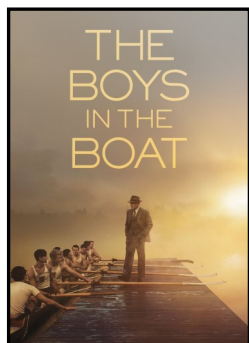

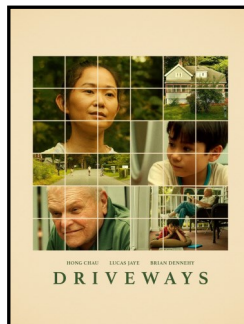

Ukiah Senior Center Financial Update

This fiscal year has been an extremely challenging one for the Center. We have faced these financial road-blocks in the past but this year we hit a major "pothole."

Our Annual Pledge drive occurs in early November each year and generates donations from our steadfast donors of approximately \$80K-\$90K. This year, pledge mailing went out a week earlier than usual and only generated \$33K. This is a hit to our budget of \$47,000 that we anticipated as income to operate but did not receive.

Interim Executive Director, Lisa Silva, met with her team of employees who brainstormed ways to save money. Ideas included reduced operating hours and a reduction in working hours for a majority of staff. These efforts on the part of staff are commended but doesn't bridge that "financial gap." USC doesn't want to cut its program and services any further. You can HELP!
