

Jim's devotion to the Center and its future legacy, subsequently moved him to make an enormously generous offer.

Jim decided to pledge annual contributions to the



Capital Project in the amount of \$100,000 over a period of five years, after which the remainer of a trust account in his name would be donated to the Capital Project.

In recognition of this generosity, USC agreed to name the future

Community Center in his name. For the first few years, Jim asked that we keep his contributions anonymous, but on his 90th birthday, Jim allowed



USC to recognize him as the tremendous benefactor he had become.

In September 2023, I was fortu-

nate to have visited with Jim during a trip to Ukiah from my new home in Ohio. Never did I believe this would be my last time seeing Jim. But he indulged my taking this selfie with him, which now I treasure greatly. No one has been a bigger friend or benefactor to the Ukiah Senior Center than Jim Busch. The Center will carry his legacy and memory for many years to come.

letter before publication and always made a point of thanking staff. Although soft-spoken, she made all of us feel appreciated with a smile and a twinkle in her eyes. She was always on hand at major events, greeting people at the front desk and enjoyed serving Thanksgiving Dinner every year.






