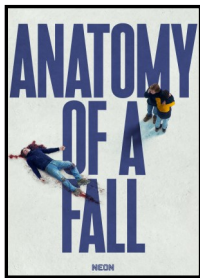

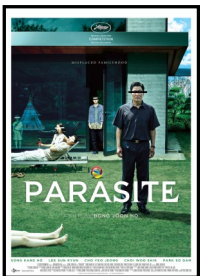

Greed and class discrimination threaten the newly formed symbiotic relationship between the wealthy Park family and the destitute Kim clan.

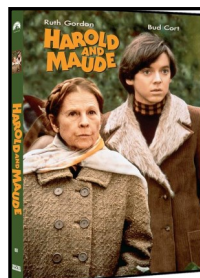


July 19 - *Young Frankenstein*

Transportation Update

USC Transportation fleet currently consists of four buses and a van, all of which are wheelchair accessible. Our service area is along Hwy 101 corridor from Hopland on the south end to Laughlin Way in Redwood Valley on the north. We are applying for an extension north to Mobile Village Way at Ridge-wood Ranch, as neither MTA nor Willits Senior Center currently serve this ar-
ea.

In Fiscal Year 2023-2024 our seven drivers have provided rides to 6,855 passengers and accrued 30,362 miles! We ask that riders respect the drivers and their fellow passengers by being ready on time for their sched-
uled pick up at the designated location. If a driver has to wait or look for you, it can make him late for the next scheduled passenger.

We provide *door-thru-door service*, which means a driver can help you access the bus from your home and assist you in carrying packages upon your return. As a courtesy to our drivers, help them adhere to the rule of 3 bags maximum of shopping items per passenger. It is also very helpful if you use a pre-paid bus card or have correct fare or small bills as the drivers don't carry much change.

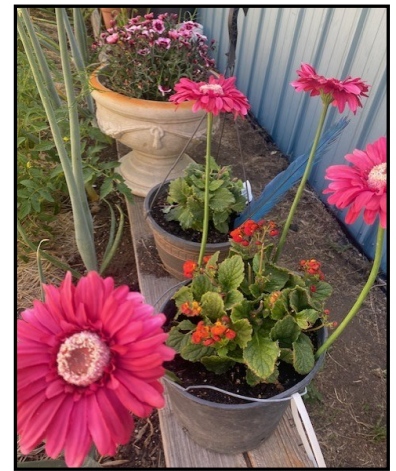
